- Awareness, education and knowledge acquisition about malaria.
- Bite prevention through the control of mosquito breeding grounds and the use of Personal Protection measures including the use of mosquito repellent and sleeping under a mosquito net.
- Ensure Continual Improvement of our structures, processes and systems.
- Early Diagnosis and treatment.

Whilst ICS will demonstrate visible leadership to malaria management, everyone has an individual responsibility to be aware of his or her contribution to managing malaria risk effectively.
